Dear Parents.

As you relax over the summer, please take time to check and restock uniform and PE kits, making sure that everything fits and is clearly named and remains so all year. Children all require a water bottle every day – no other drinks, please - and if you are buying new bags and coats, please aim to make these as compact as practical as cloakrooms rarely hold all items if things are too bulky. Our uniform requirements, which we ask you to carefully adhere to, can be found here: https://www.shipbourne.kent.sch.uk/uniform/. Please note, leggings or casual trousers/shorts are not suitable for PE – tracksuit trousers and sports shorts only, and trainers should be black/and or white. Don't forget that earrings must always be removed for PE and swimming so piercing is best planned for the start of the summer break. Children in Hampton and Fairlawne Class require a pencil case with pencils, blue handwriting pens, scissors, glue stick and colouring pencils. These should be restocked every school break so that children have what they need for learning. We do have school stock for use in emergencies, but these quickly become depleted if children arrive in school regularly without their own equipment. All children may bring healthy snacks to school, but remember that fresh is preferred and nuts are not permitted – please do all you can to restrict processed and packaged foods at snack time and lunch time.

Details can be found on our website and more information will be shared next term through Class Dojo, planned open events and parent meetings. Please look carefully at all the dates and attend those you can.
